

FEAST OF ST MOTHER TERESA OF CALCUTTA

The 5th of September is the feast day of Mother Teresa. Born on 26 August 1910 at Skopje in Macedonia. She left home at the age of 18 to join the Sisters of Loreto in Ireland, where she received the name Sister Mary Teresa, after St Thérèse of Lisieux. In 1931 she was assigned to the order's Calcutta house and taught at their school there, where she eventually became headmistress. She received a new vocation to help the poor and destitute, and in 1948, obeying this call, she left the convent and took up a new life caring for them wherever they might be: lying sick in the street or even dying in dustbins. Some of her former pupils joined her, one by one, and the new congregation of the Missionaries of Charity was established in the Diocese of Calcutta in 1950, spreading across India and eventually onto every continent. Mother Teresa died on 5th September 1997 and was beatified by Pope John Paul II on 19th October 2003 and canonized by Pope Francis on 4th Sept 2016.
