

CHRISTIAN LITERATURE

What good does it do to speak learnedly about the Trinity if, lacking humility, you displease the Trinity? FEAST OF ST PETER CLAVER (1582 – 1654)

Peter Claver was a Spanish Jesuit priest and missionary born in Catalonia, Spain, who due to his life and work became the patron saint of slaves. He worked in Colombia, South America, at the height of the slave trade. He befriended and baptized some 300,000 African slaves over a 40-year period. Peter called himself Aethioporum servus (slave of the Africans), he dedicated himself completely to their welfare. The Spanish Council of Tarragona in 1727 named him Apostle of the West Indies; and Father James Brodrick, the Jesuit historian, described him as 'a fusion in one man of the Curé d'Ars, St Francis Xavier and Fr St Damian de Veuster'. He is considered a heroic example of what should be the Christian praxis of love and of the exercise of human rights. The Congress of the Republic of Colombia declared September 9 as the Human Rights national Day in his honour.
