
SAFEGUARDING SUNDAY

FEAST OF ST VINCENT DE PAUL (1581 – 1660)

The 27th Sept is the feast of Saint Vincent de Paul. Vincent was a French Catholic priest who dedicated himself to serving the poor. In 1622 Vincent was appointed a chaplain to the galleys. After working for some time in Paris among imprisoned galley slaves, he returned to be the superior of what is now known as the Congregation of the Mission, or the "Vincentians". These priests, with vows of poverty, chastity, obedience, and stability, were to devote themselves entirely to the people in smaller towns and villages. He was instrumental in establishing seminaries, and founded the Congregation of the Mission and Daughters of Charity of Saint Vincent de Paul. He was renowned for his compassion, humility, and generosity. Vincent was canonized in 1737.
