Today is the First Sunday of Advent. Dark November will soon be past when we turn the page of the calendar to December. In the Church's calendar it is the First Sunday of Advent, the beginning of the new liturgical year. Advent means coming: the past coming of Jesus Christ at the first Christmas; the future coming of Christ at the end of life; and the everyday coming of Christ in a daily relationship.
