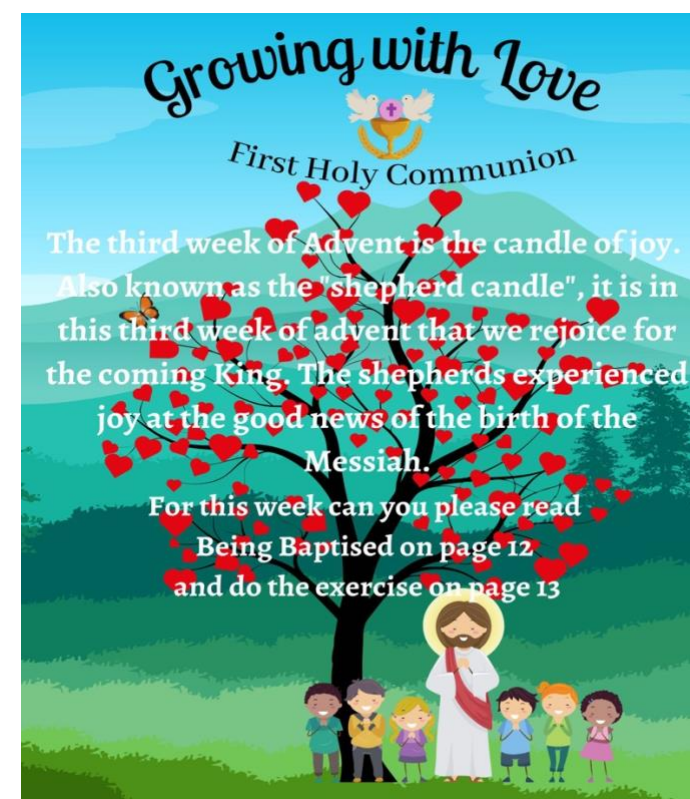
CARE FOR THE SICK AND HOUSEBOUND
