"The world promises you comfort, but you were not made for comfort. You were made for greatness."

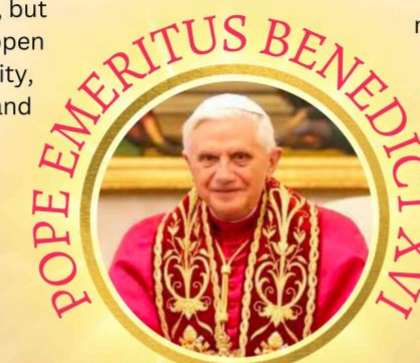
