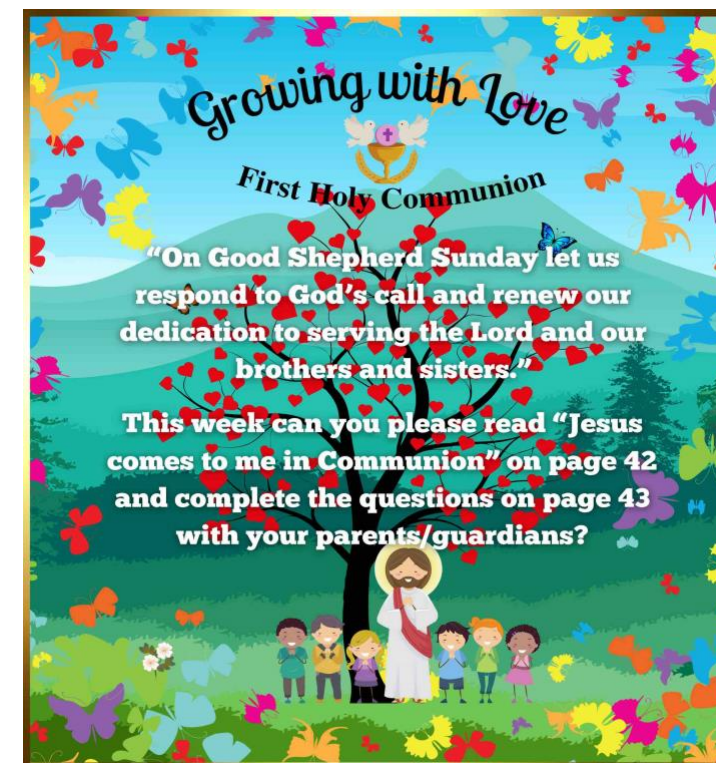
EASTER DUES
