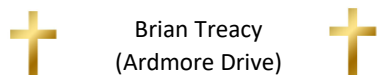

### The Church-24 Survey

You are being asked for 15 to 20 minutes of your time to complete a survey that will enable you to give your perspective, share what you believe about some significant issues, and relate your experiences of church life since the pandemic.

The Church-24 survey has three main objectives:

- To listen to churchgoers on a range of long-standing issues and questions, particularly as they are being brought to light in the synodal process.
- To explore some new issues that face us now, or soon will, but which were not talked about so much a decade ago, such as climate change, artificial intelligence, assisted dying or safeguarding procedures.
